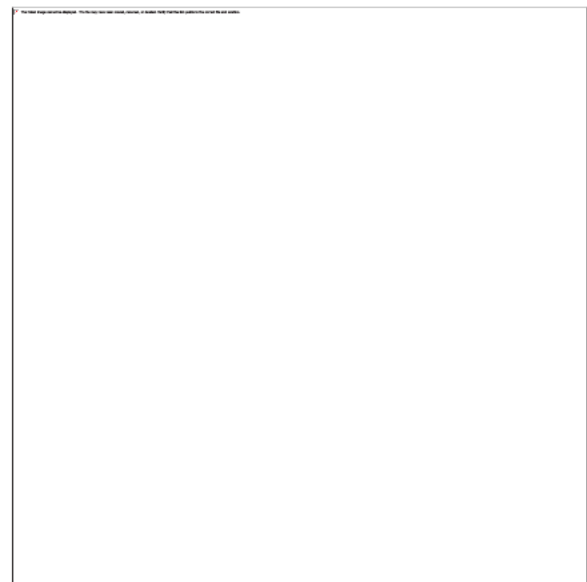

On 25 July 2022, Art.4.1.b, Art.4.1.b TRADE C2, met on their request with Art.4.1.b, and Art.4.1.b, Art.4.1.b, TATA Consultancy Services (TCS). The meeting was also attended by Art.4.1.b, TRADE C2, and Art.4.1.b, TRADE B2.

The Commission provided a brief update on the state of play of EU-India trade negotiations.

TCS underlined the importance they attach to the conclusion of an EU-India FTA, though recognised the difficulty of concluding by the deadline of the end of 2023. TCS emphasised in particular the need to include mobility of high-skilled workers as part of the agreement. On the moratorium on e-commerce, TCS stressed that more studies would be needed before an informed position could be taken by the Indian government.
